6	(b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—Of the
7	amounts otherwise appropriated for each of fiscal year
8	2025 though fiscal year 2030, for juvenile justice pro-
9	grams—
10	(1) \$100,000,000 shall be made available for
11	grants under title V of the Juvenile Justice and De-
12	linquency Prevention Act of 1974 (34 U.S.C. note et
13	seq.); and
14	(2) \$25,000,000 of the amount under para-
15	graph (1) shall be made available to carry out a pro-
16	gram for youth gun violence prevention.
