I am requesting funding for the Youth Crime and Recidivism Reduction Through Workforce Opportunity in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Exalt Youth (exalt), located at 17 Battery Place, New York, NY 10004. The funding would be used to expand youth intervention and Alternative to Incarceration (ATI) model by 100 seats (delivered in five cohorts over one year) within NY10. This expansion addresses the urgent need for scalable, developmentally appropriate programs for justice-involved youth ages 15–19.
