The funding would be used to replace the rooftop water tanks, including related piping, pump controls, and any needed associated painting or improvements to the rooftop structures. The old and deteriorated wood roof tanks have growing mold, vegetation, and have also been prone to animal intrusion, putting the water at risk of contamination.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the upgrades to the roof tanks system at this public housing development will ensure up-to-date equipment to address potential health and safety concerns about the water for the more than 1,500 residents at the Rutgers Houses.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(4).
